### RULES OF THE HOUSE

No dress code.

Members must be approved or personally nominated by the Royal Academicians and be connected to the arts; by practising, working or supporting either the visual, fine, applied or performing arts, architecture or creative industries. All memberships will be approved by the Nominations Committee.

Membership cards are needed to gain access to the Room and to order food and drinks.

Members and their guests must sign in to the Academicians' Room welcome book on arrival.

Members must accompany their guests at all times and are responsible for their code of conduct.

No person under the age of 18 will be admitted without prior permission of the membership team or the manager on duty at the time.

Membership entitles you to bring up to three guests. If you would like to bring more than three guests please arrange in advance.

The use of mobile devices for taking calls is not permitted in the Academicians' Room, however, they can be used in other areas of the Keeper's House. WiFi is also available for you to enjoy. Please ask a member of staff for the Academicians' Room code.

No smoking is allowed, however smoking is permitted in the Keeper's House Garden.

Pets are not permitted on the premises, however guide dogs are allowed.

Please do leave the premises quietly at all times in consideration of our neighbours.

Please seek written permission from the membership team if you would like to take photographs.

Members' information is held in the strictest confidence; we expect the same confidentiality from our members too.

Any dispute of the Academicians' Room rules should be taken up with the management.
