

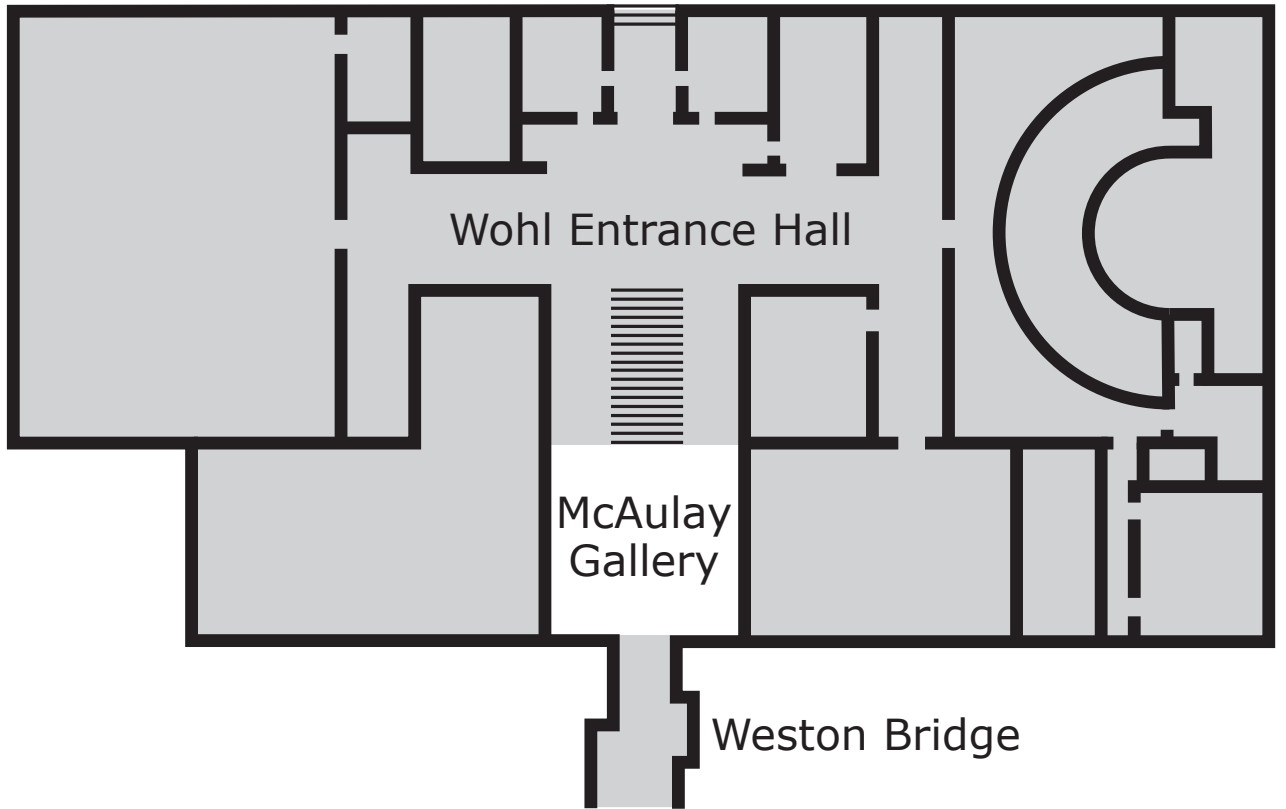

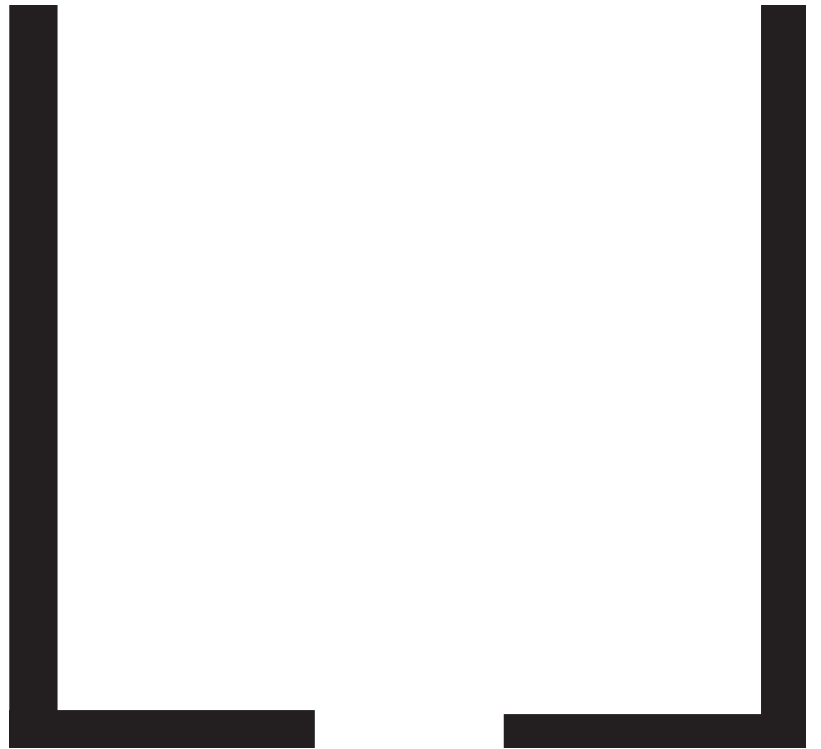

McAulay Gallery

It is fitting that, in celebration of the RA's 250th anniversary, the Summer Exhibition has spread out from the Main Galleries into the RA's other exhibition spaces.

This is the first time that visitors will be able to experience part of the Summer Exhibition for free – which feels appropriate given this year's coordinator Grayson Perry CBE RA's mission to be as democratic and inclusive as possible in the selection of works.

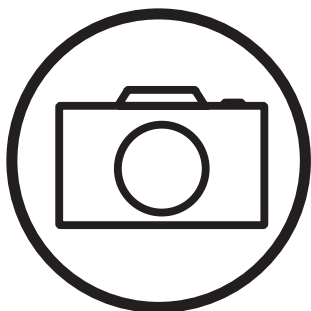
Perry has named the McAulay Gallery his 'Room of Fun', but there are serious concerns at play here.

Direct and darkly comical, David Shrigley's twenty 'front pages' force us to confront the oversaturation of media messaging. The irreverent small-scale sculptures in front – which Perry describes as "beautiful things" – come primarily from the open submission.

Martin Parr's series of photographs taken in India shows how we document our experiences (including, of course, taking selfies), suggesting the idea of looking without necessarily seeing.

Another group of works nearby – this time small paintings of visitors in galleries – depicts a more considered act of looking.

To complete this room, Perry has chosen a selection of portraits of himself and his alter ego Claire, including a knitted work by Rod Melvin from his 'British Artists' series. These pose an intriguing question: how does one artist see another?
