



Auguste Vacquerie (19 November 1819–19 February 1895) was a French journalist and man of letters. William François Marie Ritter (31 May 1867 – 19 March 1955) was a Swiss novelist, critic and painter. Amédée Henri Guillemin (1860–1941) was a French Général de Division who served in World War I. During the war, he commanded the 121st Infantry Division, the 131st Infantry Division, the 53rd Infantry Division and the 19th Infantry Division. There is a good chance that this was in the collection of Ritter or Henri Guillemin during WWII, but the dates are unknown.
